Cleanaway transfer stations

Transfer stations act as a central location in the waste management process. Local collection vehicles unload waste for sorting, compaction and reloading into larger vehicles. This improves operational efficiency, reduces traffic movements and supports resource recovery.

Key functions

- **Waste consolidation:** Local collection vehicles unload waste at the transfer station. The waste is then combined into larger vehicles for transport to recycling facilities or landfill. This reduces the number of long-distance truck movements.
- **Sorting and resource recovery:** Where applicable, materials such as recyclables or hazardous items are separated to support safe handling and responsible disposal.
- **Compaction:** Waste is compacted to maximise transport efficiency, reducing fuel use and overall vehicle trips.
- **Community access:** Transfer stations can provide a convenient drop-off location for residents and small businesses, including for bulky items.
- **Environmental safeguards:** The facility operates under environmental approvals and includes controls to minimise noise, dust, traffic and other potential impacts.
