Acknowledgement of Country, welcome and introductions, agenda overview

AS gave project update: Referral agency process is now complete; technical reports are available on BERC website prior to Office of Coordinator-General release; SDA application public consultation (through Office of Coordinator-General) is expected in October and November; project decision expected early 2027. Provided hand out of technical reports guidance fact sheet.

Deep dive presentation: Transport and Traffic Assessment – Madison Taylor, Senior Traffic Engineer, Arup

Add pavement impact assessment to reports available online

Overview of traffic assessment methodology, TMR Guide to Traffic Impact Assessment and TMR consultation to date.

Based on community consultation, truck route will be Beaudesert Bypass Road and the Mount Lindesay Highway to and from the site, not through the Beaudesert town centre.

Proposed upgrade discussed at Beaudesert Bypass Road / Mt Lindesay Highway / Brisbane Street / Helen Street intersection.

Developer contribution proposed to TMR for pavement maintenance.

Deep dive presentation: Water use and management, Anna Stewart, Project Manager, Arup

Overview of water demand and use to operate the facility and water connection to water main.

Recycled water opportunities explored with Queensland Urban Utilities for Class A recycled water network to the Bromelton State Development Area.

Stormwater management discussion with reference to site plan.

Public submission look ahead

DB provided fact sheet hand out explaining the State Development Area public consultation process. Referenced the Office of the Coordinator-General consultation hub.

Consultation period expected 1 October – 16 November, an extension of the usual 15 business days.

Specialists will be available by appointment to answer technical questions and assist with public submissions in October. Dates to be advised.

Noting the finalisation of the planning application process, this will be the last Stakeholder Reference Group meeting for this phase. If the project proceeds, Cleanaway will establish a community reference group with a different focus and Terms of Reference.
