

Erskine Park Transfer Station Usage Directions

As a minimum the following PPE must be worn at all times when tipping at the Erskine Park Transfer Station



Long Sleeves /Pants



Hi-Vis
Clothes or
Vest



Safety Shoes



⊠ Gloves



Safety Glasses



Hearing
Protection



Hard Hat



All drivers entering the Erskine Park Transfer Station:

- Must hold a valid licence for any vehicles and/or plant they operate.
- Being unimpaired by drugs & alcohol.
- No use of mobile phones whilst operating any plant and or vehicle.
- Obtaining acknowledgement from the operator.
- Never entering an exclusion zone, unless permitted
- all vehicles must be fitted with working UHF Radio



1 UNCOVER LOAD HERE

Uncover load if applicable. No climbing on truck/trailer



WEIGHBRIDGE
Proceed to the weighbridge



3 Tune UHF/CB radio to site frequency 25.



4 Queue at the light and await door allocation.



Reverse slowly up to the allocated door and await the door to open.

Reverse into the shed and into the allocated area as directed by our staff member.

6 Ensure you leave a minimum of 4m between your vehicle and any other vehicle at the tip face.



Manual opening tail gates, i.e hook lifts: stay within 1m pedestrian Zone of your truck. Make visual contact with the loader operator.



8 Reverse up to the stockpile or as directed by TS operators. Please ensure you have your hazard lights on when exiting the vehicle.



9 Clear out and close tailgate.



10 Proceed to the door and await the green light and the door to completely open before leaving.



1) Proceed to exit the weighbridge and receive the docket.



Driver Responsibilities

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

DOS

- ✓ Report to site office / weighbridge upon arrival on site
- ✓ Wear the required PPE, safety boots and vest at all times
- ✓ Obey all speed limits and signs while on each site
- ✓ Folow all instructions given by site staff
- ✓ Use wheel wash when directed
- ✓ Ensure all foreign objects are removed from dual rear wheels prior to exiting the site
- ✓ Watch out for all pedestrians, other moving vehicles and plant particularly when reversing
- ✓ Obey tipping area directions at all times
- ✓ Watch out for uneven ground when positioning your vehicle
- ✓ Ensure your vehicle is stable and level before discharging load.
- Ensure adequate distance between vehicles when discharging loads
- ✓ Obey 5m exclusion zone between all vehicles
- √ Immediately report all incidents/accidents to site staff
- ✓ Use all vehicle equipment properly
- ✓ Be patient and follow rules
- ✓ Seat belts are to be worn at all times whilst on site.

DON'TS

- Don't allow any crew member other than the driver out of the vehicle
- Don't bring children or animals onto the site
- Don't deviate from designated haul roads
- Don't overtake other vehicles and plant on haul roads
- Don't un-tarp or unlatch the rear of your vehicle before arrival at the designated tipping area
- Don't sort through waste
- Don't stand or walk under an unpropped body or tailgate
- Don't walk behind vehicles
- Don't climb on the vehicle to un-tarp the load
- Don't travel with the vehicle body raised
- Don't tip both trays at once
- Don't smoke anywhere on site other than in designated areas

TIPPING PROCEDURE

- Uncover Load if applicable
- > Always stay within the 1m "Pedestrian Zone" of your vehicle
- > Obey 5m exclusion zone between all vehicles
- Do not climb on vehicles
- Ensure no person/plant/equipment is in the immediate vicinity of your truck while reversing
- > Be aware of surface soft spots. Ensure your area is firm enough for the safe tipping of the load
- Open and firmly secure the tail gate
- Reverse to the tip location
- Tip/Discharge the load
- > Engage Hazard lights when out of the vehicle
- Clean up and securely lock the tail gate.
- Leave the site by following "Exit" signage
